This creates opportunities to foster community spirit and respect, by being connected and engaged with the financial advice profession.

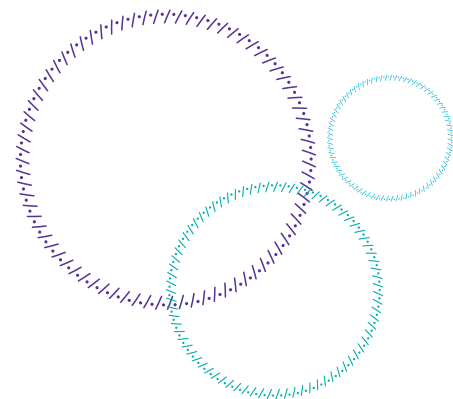
About the Grants Program
